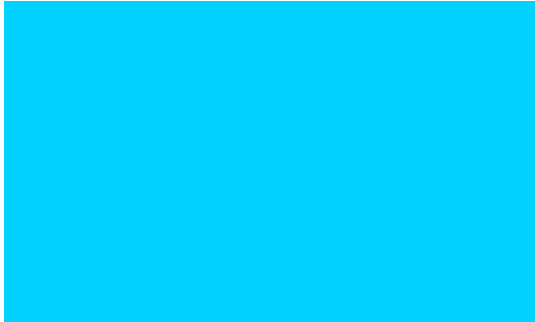


## 36 Wilentz Attorneys Named to New Jersey Super Lawyers and Rising Stars Lists

A total of 36 Wilentz attorneys have been recognized in the 2020 edition of New Jersey *Super Lawyers* for excellence in their fields. 29 attorneys have been named to the Super Lawyers list and seven attorneys as "Rising Stars."

*Super Lawyers* is published by *Thomson Reuters*. Candidates are evaluated on 12 indicators of peer recognition and professional achievement. Selections are made on an annual, state-by-state basis. Each year, only five percent of lawyers in the state of New Jersey are selected as Super Lawyers and 2.5 percent are selected as Rising Stars. The aforementioned organization is a private peer review organization, not a court specific public certification vehicle.
