



## Everett M. Johnson Named to the New Jersey Law Journal’s List of “Diverse Attorneys of the Year”

Wilentz Shareholder Everett M. Johnson has been named to the list of Diverse Attorneys of the Year by the *New Jersey Law Journal*.
