ORDERED that:

This Order applies to all of the cases consolidated pursuant to the Court Order of Consolidation for Discovery Purposes Only, [Doc. No. 28, filed 02/19/20], (“Consolidated Cases”).

1. The February 19, 2019 Order for Stay entered by Judge Wolfson is hereby vacated as to the Consolidated Cases as defined above;
2. Defendants shall file answers to the complaints in the Consolidated Cases on or before February 19, 2020;
3. The parties shall serve Rule 26 Disclosures by February 5, 2020;
4. Written discovery shall be served by February 12, 2020;
5. Defendants shall respond to all written discovery by or before April 15, 2020;
6. Plaintiffs shall submit a completed Plaintiff Profile Form by or before April 15, 2020 (and there will be a separate case management order entered on the Plaintiff Profile Forms);
7. All other discovery on individual Plaintiffs in the Consolidated Cases and future Plaintiffs whose Ethicon Hernia Mesh cases become Consolidated Cases under the consolidated or

coordinated management of Judges Wolfson and Arpert in the District of New Jersey are hereby stayed until further Order of The Court;

Discovery previously served and to be served in the *In re Physiomesh Litigation (Flexible Composite Mesh)*, Master Docket No. ATL-L-2122-18, MCL Case No. 627, *In re Proceed Mesh Litigation*, Master Docket No. ATL-L-794-19, MCL Case No. 630, and *In re Prolene Hernia System Mesh Litigation*, Master Case No. ATL-L-173-20, Case No. 633, is deemed to have been taken or served in the Consolidated Cases; and
