Her environmental litigation experience includes representing a public utility in matters involving the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) and the New Jersey Spill Compensation and Control Act (Spill Act).

Ms. Kinback's legal experience is complemented by her background as a civil engineer and she maintains her New Jersey Professional Engineer license. Before practicing law, she served as a senior engineer with the Ocean County Department of Engineering, where she designed roads, stormwater management systems and recreational facilities and managed construction projects involving contractors, consultants, utility companies, and county counsel.
